
## The Comeback Kids of Colorado

The No. 3 seed Denver Nuggets broke a number of records during the 2020 NBA playoffs. The Nuggets are the first team in NBA history to come back from multiple 3-1 series deficits, beating the 6-seed Utah Jazz and 2-seed Los Angeles Clippers in 7 games. Nuggets guard Jamal Murray and Utah guard Donovan Mitchell also set scoring records in a single series. The Nuggets advanced to the Western Conference Finals, eventually losingin 5 games to the Los Angeles Lakers, who won the NBA championship Sunday.

## The birth of a star Jamal Murray went head-to-head with some of the NBA's biggest stars in the playoffs. He and Donovan Mitchell combined for the most 50-point games in a playoff series, doubling the previous record of 4.
