HOOSIERS REHOMED

In 2019, Indiana ranked fourth nationally among states with the highest rate of children in foster care. Within Indiana, the counties with the highest rate of children in fostercare were located in the south and southeast of the state. Despite this, Indiana does tend to have better outcomes for children than the U.S as a whole, with more children ultimately being reunited with their birth parents.
